Introduction

The Traditional Tae Kwon-Do Federation (TTF) is committed to protecting the data collected about its members.

Information Collection Policies:

The Traditional Tae Kwon-Do Federation collects the information you provide at registration including your name, email address and any contact numbers. We may use this information to, for example:

- Email you with information about the website or other Traditional Tae Kwon-Do Federation products and services.
- Understand how you have been using the site and tailor the information we provide to you accordingly.
- Allow our website host to verify website usage statistics.

You should be aware that if we are requested by the police or any regulatory or government authority investigating suspected illegal activities to access and disclose individually identifiable information concerning your activities whilst using our website, we shall do so.

We also reserve the right to disclose individually identifiable information to third parties where a complaint arises concerning your use of our website, and that use is deemed by us inconsistent with these conditions.

You agree that you do not object to us contacting you for any of the above purposes whether by telephone, email or in writing and you confirm that you do not and will not consider any of the above as being a breach of any of your rights under the Telecommunications (Data Protection and Privacy) Regulations 1999.

Registration Information:

The Traditional Tae Kwon-Do Federation will collect the details from your registration and disclaimed form and hold them on file. The Traditional Tae Kwon-Do Federation will not sell or forward your personally identifiable information onto any third parties.

The Traditional Tae Kwon-Do Federation will not knowingly collect any information from children under 16 via the website. If we become aware that we have done so, we will immediately nullify all personally identifiable information collected from them.

Special Cases:

We may disclose personally identifiable information to third parties when required by law or is pertinent to judicial or government investigations or proceedings, or otherwise necessary to protect our website or the safety of its users.
